By quantifying embodied carbon and other key indicators, the EPD equips engineers, contractors, and municipalities with credible information to support sustainable procurement, meet Buy Clean California requirements, and comply with evolving state and federal environmental reporting standards.

The Company intends to differentiate its marketing of water transmission systems by integrating the EPD into the commercial bidding process for customers and project owners, usually municipalities, responsible for navigating environmental criteria within their broader infrastructure planning.
